



## Welcome to Hägglunds IoFK!

Hi, we are so glad that you and/or your child are going to participate in our soccer club!

This is a short information about our club with the basic information about Hägglunds IoFK. If you have questions don't hesitate to contact your team manager or the coach in your team.

## Hägglunds IoFK

Hägglunds IoFK was founded 1935 as a freetime club that was going to activate the employees in the company AB Hägglund and Sons in Gullänget (today BAE Systems).

During the years the club and our arena Bussbyvallen has grown larger and larger. We have mainly been focusing on soccer, cross country skiing, orienteering and gymnastics.

Since 2 years are we offering soccer and gymnastics. Cross country skiing and orienteering have started up their own clubs.

We are approximately 800 members, have approximately 450 soccer players in your youth teams and approximately 70 players in our senior teams.

## Hägglunds IoFK

### – a non profit organisation with a lot of volunteers

Most of the clubs in Sweden are bases on volunteer work, it means we have no employed people making our basic tasks in the club. Our parents in the club are doing the work in their freetime.

We have two employees who are taking care of the administration (Bo Häggkvist) and our arena Bussbyvallen (Hans-Erik Köhn).

Our board, coaches, team managers and other people in your teams do their tasks in their freetime.

It makes us very dependent on the fees the club has and the work efforts our members are doing together. Otherelse the club wouldn't work.



## THESE ARE THE FEES WE HAVE IN HIoFK

- member fee
- season fee
- team contribution fee
- and also a sales activity

### Member fee

Our member fee is 300 SEK per year. If your family has more than one player there's also a possibility to pay a family membership. The family fee is 550 SEK.

The member fee and the season fee shall be paid before first league game for the season. Otherwise the player is not allowed to play.

If you haven't received the invoice with the member fee and the season fee you shall contact Anders Omnell ([anders@omnell.nu](mailto:anders@omnell.nu)).

**We are using the member fee** to cover the clubs major costs concerning the arena, heating of facilities, machines, staff and other general costs.

### Season fee

The season fee depends on the member's/player's age and looks like this:

- 7 – 12 years 320 SEK/player and year
- 13 – 17 years 320 SEK/player and year
- 18 and more, desired of the team

**We are using the season fee to cover** our costs for coach- and player educations/camps, update of our balls every year, insurances for the players, parts of the work we are doing with our soccer fields.

### Team contribution fee

All teams have an yearly contribution fee. This fee should be collected by working on a task together. It is not meant that each player pays the sum themselves.

The fee is depending on the team member's age:

- 8 years: 0 SEK
- 9 years: 6 000 SEK/team and year, (max 300 SEK/player)
- 10 – 12 years: 9 000 SEK/team and year, (max 600 SEK/player)
- 13 – 17 år: 12 000 SEK/team and year, (max 900 SEK/player)
- Senior: depending on which league the team is playing in

The team contribution fee shall be collected by the team doing some kind of labor together.

**We are using the Team contribution fee to** league fees, material (such as game dresses, vests, etc), referee fees, parts of the costs we have for our soccer fields.



## The club's yearly sales activity

As an addition to the fees we also have an yearly sales activity in the club. This activity is performed in the spring time and each player can choose to sell some products we choose every year or just pay the fee directly. You can find more information about this on the website, unfortunately in Swedish.

## PARENT SUPPORT TO THE TEAM

There are a couple of activities that our players' parents **must** participate in. If you can't participate you have to arrange with a replacement person.

- Renoveringsdagen in May. We have one day when we together are freshing up Bussbyvallen.
- The yearly sales activity
- Staffing our cafeteria, check your e-mail and the team's website for info
- Game host and assistant referee

### Check the team's calender and web site

Parents in our teams have to help their children paying attention to the calender at the team's web site. We don't accept coming late to practice and game due to that you haven't checked the web site.

We also ask our parents in the teams to make sure that invitations sent via e-mail are responded to in time.
